

A word, or two from our Pastor...

Dear Members and Friends of Immanuel United Church of Christ,

Summer is almost gone and the school year is just around the corner. This has been a wonderful summer for me. Just being alive after the transplant procedure I had in December has made me appreciate time so much more than in the past. Though I continue to be weak and easily tired, every day I get just a little better. So, any opportunity I had over the summer to enjoy music, activities, or the outdoors was a wonderful blessing.

But now that Summer is nearly over, I look forward with great joy to the Fall. My hope is that Rally Day will be a new start to inspire us all to consistent participation in our community. To inspire this, I'm beginning a nine-week series on Rally Day called, "More Than Money: Stewardship as a Way of Life." In this series, we will consider the responsibility we have in regard to the many resources we possess. As I have been contemplating the various aspects of stewardship, I recall a story about a mother of a young child whose Sunday School teacher asked to speak with her one day. The teacher said to the mother, "Your daughter does not want to put her Sunday School offering into the basket". The teacher stated that when she asked the little girl "why she didn't want to give her offering", the girl replied, "because I have my own piggy bank at home". The mother had a talk with her daughter about why she should **share** what she has, and that part of sharing is putting money into the Sunday School offering basket.

If you didn't already guess, this story is about my mother and me and was probably my first lesson in financial stewardship. As the years went on, Mom taught me about other aspects of stewardship. She demonstrated stewardship of time through volunteering for various church organizations and being a girl scout leader. She demonstrated stewardship of talents by helping to sew banners for the sanctuary, making table favors for use at church celebrations or by making lap robes for shut ins. I don't know if Mom intentionally set out to teach me about stewardship, but as I look back on her life she certainly did.


