
Mission Statement of Immanuel Church

Dear Members and Friends of Immanuel United Church of Christ,



As we look to the 2023 Gala as a way to support Immanuel's India Minsitry, our focus this year is "celbrating how far we've come and maintaining the good works that are being done"!

Our history "in a nutshell"...

In 2005, Immanuel Church, as a whole, agreed to financially support Novahu Valluri and his family as they began their mission of ministering and educating the poorest of the poor in the village of Madhavapatnam...we began with a one room school house, 5 students and the desire to shine the light of Christ in this area. Within 1 year, enrollment was up to 35 children... Shortly after that first year, Joyful Journeys, Incorporated, a 501(c)3 organization was established by Immanuel Church as a way to help support and sustain the growth of our church's ministry.





Other ministries that started early on were the Cutting & Tailoring Centers teaching women a trade, Joful Journey Hostel for orphans, and a Lunch Bunch program to feed hungry students.



The first of many major expansions within the ministry was the purchase of a building to accommodate Marshall School and the now 60 students enrolled. This structure was bought for \$6,000 by Immanuel Church. The second expansion, also made that year, was the purchase of a building to house Novahu and his family as well as serve as the JJ Hostel.

Members of Immanuel raised \$13,000 for that purchase





Over the next several years through the continued generosity of our Immanuel Church family and friends, additions were made to Marshall School to accommodate the ever growing number of students. A larger home was built for the Valluri family and hostel children, with the main floor being utilized for the Cutting and Tailoring program, school assemblies and weekly worship.



In 2014, through personal support and fundraising at Immanuel Church, Terri's Dining Hall was built, providing an area for students and hostel children to eat, and Bill's Light Center for Computer Training was constructed offering both students and adults a space to learn technilogical skills.



That same year, through the combined efforts of Immanuel Church along with the Kakinada and West Bend Rotary Clubs, Lora's Living Water, a water filtration system, was installed serving students and community members clean drinking water.





Other ministries that Joyful Jouneys maintains are the House Pastor program which equips and supports individuals in sharing the Gospel within neighboring villages, and Oma's Oldsters, a fund that offers assistance with neccesities to seniors in the community.





With money raised through Immanuel's India Gala, the latest additions to the Marshall School were added in 2017 offering space for a science lab, a library and the 450 students that attend there. The Landowgals Fashion Technology and Computer Training Institute was also completed; this new structure gives impoverished women a place to come to learn skills and build self confidence.





Through the shear generosity of one donor, a school bus was purchased in 2019. This gift opened doors for impoverished children from neighboring communities to attend Marshall School in addition to transporting the students in the village of Madhavapatnam.





Following a Mission Trip to India in 2020, a passionate supporter of JJM initiated the expansion of the Joyful Journeys Hostel with the building of a separate Boys Dorm. Donations made outside of normal pledges provided sufficient funding to offer these children a more spacious place to call home.





After needing to scrap vehicles that were purchased in the earlier stages of this ministry, a request for a van to help transport the hostel children as well as to be used in for daily marketing was made. In 2022 a Memorial Fund was established in honor of Joyful Journeys Board member, Big Bob; through the outpouring of donations a Mini Bus was purchased.

We have so much to celebrate; join us on our journey!



Unable to attend the India Gala? There are still ways to support the event and the ministry it impacts. Prayers for its success are certainly appreciated as are "In Kindness" donations. The money generated from both the Gala and Silent Auction help to enable us to continue the good works being done in the village of Madhavapatnam and beyond; together we are making a positive difference.








RAISE RIGHT GIFT CARDS (formally known as SCRIP)






