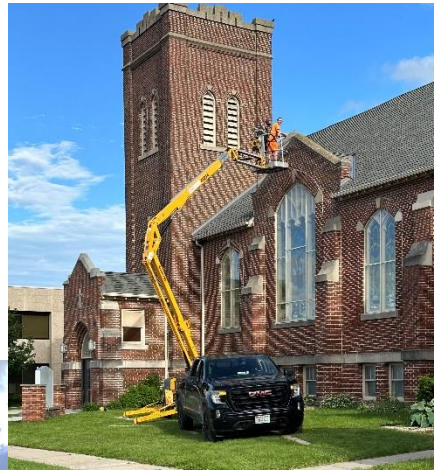


Property update...

Here's the latest,

Kettle Moraine Heating and A/C did their Peace of Mind service for our Air Conditioners. All the A/C units were serviced and the fan motor on one of the larger A/C unit that services the south side of the sanctuary failed. The fan motor was replaced but it came with a cost of \$1,050.51. They also replaced a thermostat that failed which was identified last fall. It wasn't replaced at that time because its only function is for air conditioning. The cost for that item was \$168.27. Thanks to Glenn Radzinski and Mike Soener for opening up the church and assisting KMH.

Ben Russell is in the process of investigating the water damage to our large stain glass window in the sanctuary. Ben and Josh Thull, assisted by Glenn, found loose anchors and high potential areas where water could be entering. Repairs happened on June 5th. Dave checked moisture content June 26th and it has gone down in some spots (great considering the amount rain) but still needs to dry out longer before drywall repairs happen. We thought we had this issue taken care of in November of 2020 and hope the repairs to it continue in the right direction. Thank you, Ben.

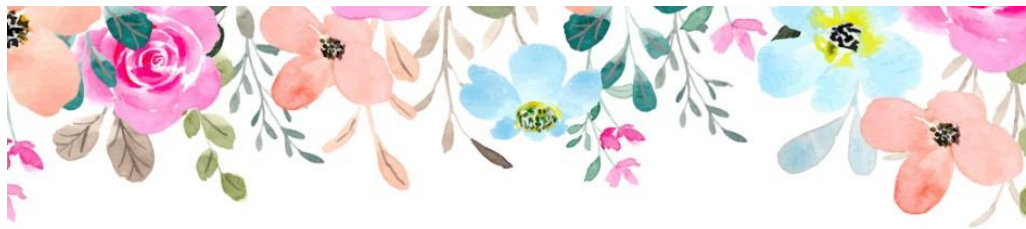

Faithfulness: Showing you love God in front of others.

Gentleness: Treating others gently.

Self-Control: Showing discipline, especially when frustrated or angry.

Within the Indian culture, school enrollment is a lengthy process; because of traditional customs, families have almost a 2-month window in which to register their children. Obviously, this is very different from what we are used to here in America, however over the years we have learned to wait patiently during this process as we look forward with great anticipation to see the returning faces of our beloved students and welcome in newcomers. For our sponsors, we know that you too are eager to see if your child has returned and to receive their latest photo; as we begin the process of updating the India Wall, stay tuned, we'll be in touch! 😊

Compound Wall Holds Many Good Uses

Among the Joyful Journey property in the Village of Madhavapatnam India, is a plot of land across the street from the Marshall School that has been deemed as the student's playground. For years this open space served that specific need, however it was also utilized by other people within the community because land regulations are very loose in this area. Recently, the use of this property needed to be rethought after updates to the drainage system along the road made it impossible for our JJ buses to access the secured parking area across from the Joyful Journeys Hostel. Novahu felt if we built a compound wall around the playground plot, then that piece of land could have multiple uses.

With the construction finalized, we now have a safe place for our buses to park at night, a private area solely to be utilized by the Marshall School children and staff for playground use and school assemblies, and a secure area for the students to park their bikes during the day.

Thank you to all who contribute to Joyful Journeys India General Fund, this money helps cover additional needs that arise.
