Mid-year Contribution Statements have been sent out. Please let me know if you have any questions.

As you can see below, Immanuel's giving for June was less than expenses which meant we had to borrow money from Immanuel's restricted funds once again. The *Good News* is that YTD Operating Expenses as of June 30, 2024, are \$9,664 less than last year at the end of June. **However, going into July we had zero cash available for current expenses, meaning that we owe 'Restricted Funds' \$2,806.81 plus whatever will be needed to be borrowed to meet future operating expenses. Please consider this as you continue to support Immanuel's local ministries.**

Just a reminder, when writing checks to Immanuel and Joyful Journeys please write two separate checks as this makes it easier to account for what is designated for Immanuel and what is for Joyful Journeys. Also, you can make on-line donations separately to Immanuel and Joyful Journeys via each of their websites, immanuelwestbend.org or joyfuljourneys-inc.org.

The State of WI inspected our elevator and found two things that needed attention. The battery backup and alarm bell in the elevator car needs to be replaced. Otis technician showed up today and replaced the battery, but did not have an alarm bell on hand.

He will get one and replace it as soon as possible.

The plaster around the sanctuary stained glass windows moisture level still registers quite high, mainly around where the wooden frame meets the plaster.

The wooden frame on the surface doesn't seem to be compromised,
I will keep monitoring it.

We will be doing a exterior inspection and painting as needed before cold weather comes and we will be asking for help once that is scheduled.

We are looking to repair or replace the door on the main level Women's restroom to allow easier access in and out.

Summer is not only a time when many can enjoy a vacation, or at least warmer temperatures. It is also a time when conferences and enrichment classes take place - especially for church musicians. In June, I attended the Handbell Musicians of America's Area 7 Festival, held in La Crosse WI.

Area 7 encompasses Wisconsin, Minnesota, North Dakota, South Dakota and Manitoba, so you can understand that a conference held in Wisconsin was one that I did not want to miss! Immanuel Church's generosity helped me to attend this conference - thank you!!

Here is a brief summary I wrote for HMA's newsletter:

"My original interest in attending the Area 7 HMA Festival was to gain technical knowledge and perhaps make some connections relevant to bell repair and maintenance for my church's 4 octaves of White Chapel Bells - I am a new director and have a lot to learn! The Festival did not disappoint! Each class I attended was led by knowledgeable and helpful instructors, and I left each class thinking "I can do this!!!" I felt well equipped with a head full of information, useful handouts and contact information in case I should have any questions in the future. And attending those class sessions could have been enough, but then there was the mass ringing! I had never experienced anything like it before. I was graciously adopted into an attending bell choir and made to feel welcome ringing at their assigned tables and using their bells. Everyone at the conference was friendly and helpful. No need to feel nervous! But then, the music: the stunning selections and arrangements led by two amazing clinicians. And, a WALL OF SOUND like I've seldom experienced. Being part of a team comprising approximately 265 ringers is not something I will ever forget. The icing on the cake was the concerts given by Specialty Choirs and the Bells of the Bluffs choir from Red Wing. The ringers and directors exhibited exceptional talent and technical finesse! I really experienced the full realm of the potential of bell choirs. I am grateful for financial assistance from Immanuel Church and the Clista Wood scholarship that paved the road for my attendance at the Festival. I learned the value of this Festival in the knowledge that I gained, the music that filled my heart and soul, and the contacts I met. "

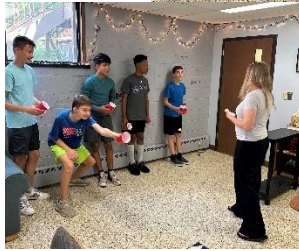
