A word, or two from our Pastor...

Dear Members and Friends of Immanuel United Church of Christ,

By the time you read this, we will have completed our series on the Book of James. Though it's a challenge to cover a whole book, the reward is that it allows our author's message to become clear and settle into our hearts and minds.

Taken as a whole, James' main intent is to inspire the church to faithfully endure the trying times they find themselves in. He constantly warns them that faith must not be reduced to mere words or beliefs, but rather, should express itself in righteous words, actions, and attitudes.

For James, religion that honors God expresses itself in three ways:

(1) healing and helping speech, (2) acts of mercy and compassion particularly toward the poor and needy, and (3) living counter-culturally. This is how he puts it: "If any think they are religious and do not bridle their tongues but deceive their hearts, their religion is worthless. Religion that is pure and undefiled before God the Father is this: to care for orphans and widows in their distress and to keep oneself unstained by the world" (1:26-27). The remainder of his book expands on these three expressions.

In regard to speech: Because it is so difficult to control our speech, we are to make every effort to speak blessings rather than curses, words of mercy rather than judgment, and words of prayer for ourselves and others and praise to God.

In regard to acts of mercy: He denounces partial and privileged treatment of the wealthy and calls the community to consider equally the needs of all. This fulfills "the royal law" of loving one's neighbor as oneself.

A community committed to wise words and merciful actions is counter-cultural: that is, it swims against the stream of a world filled with envy, pride, divisions, and strife (which James labels as "wisdom from below, unspiritual and devilish"). Instead, he charges the community to practice the "wisdom from above" that is "peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without a trace of partiality or hypocrisy" (3:17). By living counter-culturally, the church bears faithful witness to God's generous and gracious heart and Christ's call to peace.

James' message remains relevant for us in our trying times. James desires our beliefs to become behavior so that we might walk wisely and well in this world as a faithful witness to the gospel of Christ. Having completed our study of the Book of James, it is my prayer that we would all endeavor to embody and express his dream for the church, so that we aren't "mere hearers" but "active doers". Lord, have mercy. Christ, have mercy.


Offering Altar
