Dear Members and Friends of Immanuel United Church of Christ,

I am a firm believer in celebrating whenever the opportunity arises. Life is challenging and stressful. We all work so hard to accomplish the objectives we hope to achieve. And I believe that all the sweat, labor, and strain it takes to fulfill our goals ought to be rewarded as often as possible with simply cherishing and relishing the fact that our hard work has paid off.

I've been your pastor for almost nineteen years. In that time we have never fully brought in the funds to meet our budget. In my first years, we were barely hitting 50%. In subsequent years, we moved the needle forward to 80%, 90% and beyond, but could never quite hit the 100% mark.

That's why I'm elated, overjoyed, ecstatic (Can anyone give me a "Woot-Woot"?) to announce that for the first time in decades we have brought in sufficient funds to achieve our goal of meeting our 2024 expenses. We've done this in spite of the tragic loss of key members through death or moving, in spite of the shadow of Covid that still hangs over us, and in spite of all the struggles that churches throughout the nation and world are experiencing.

This is certainly cause for celebration! Who knows what the future holds, but for now, we have been faithful to maintain our witness at 5th and Walnut. Though we always have work to do, I long to simply dwell in the thought that, for now, in this present moment, we have accomplished something truly worth celebrating.

As a way of thanking you all for your faithful support and generous giving, we will have a unique service of celebration and thanksgiving on January 12 during both services. I will be providing all the treats and hope to bring inspiring words (and maybe songs!) of gratitude. I certainly hope you will make every effort to attend!


