A word, or two from our Pastor...

Dear Members and Friends of Immanuel United Church of Christ,

Having spent the Season of Epiphany learning about God's Beloved Son and experiencing his experiences with the Woman at the Well, Simon at the Lake, and the Royal Official in Cana, we now move into the Season of Lent – a season known for reevaluating our faith and commitment to the Christ.

This year our reflections will be guided by "the Seven Last Words of Christ from the Cross" (sometimes known as "the Seven Last Sayings"). The Seven Last Words come from a place of deep sacrifice and self-giving. They speak clearly of who Jesus is and how he lived and the kind of people he desires us to be. Just as we treasure the last words of loved ones in our lives, the early church treasured the last words of Jesus and found in them a gateway to understanding his heart and faithfulness.

The seven last words are:

- "Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do." (Luke 23:34)
- "Verily I say unto thee, Today shalt thou be with me in paradise." (Luke 23:43)
- "Woman, behold thy son! and Behold thy mother!" (John 19:26-27)
- · "My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?" (Matthew 27:46; Mark 15:34)
- · "I thirst." (John 19:28)
- · "It is finished." (John 19:30)
- "Father, into thy hands I commend my spirit." (Luke 23:46)

Starting on March 2, we will do a deep dive on each saying in order to learn more of Jesus and discover more of what God calls us to reflect in our Lenten Journeys (and our daily lives). The beauty, integrity, compassion, humanity, and faithfulness of Christ is on full display in these last words, pronounced even in the midst of the cold and cruel context of the cross. All of this will lead us into Holy Week and Easter.

I look forward to sharing these reflections with you during the Season of Lent. May God be with you and bless you as, together, we stand at the foot of the cross, and experience the last words of God's Beloved and our Lord.


