A word, or two from our Pastor...

Dear Members and Friends of Immanuel United Church of Christ,

It has been a joy this Lenten season to reflect deeply with you upon "the Seven Sayings of Christ from the Cross". These words of Jesus during the final moments of his earthly life have revealed to us what's on his heart as he experiences the cruel cross.

However, these sayings can be overwhelming. They all come from the dark place of death's looming grasp. And as such, on the surface, they can feel crushing. But I believe that if we view them as Christ's final stand against the powers of evil and Christ's final push to establish his kingdom, we can see great victory and triumph in his sayings.

For example, the first saying, *"Father, forgive them they know not what they do,"* can be viewed in the light of the vast forces of evil that plague Christ, and yet also as the triumph of divine forgiveness even in the worst situation. This statement of forgiveness to enemies reveals God's perfect mercy and steadfast love for all, even enemies.

The saying, *"Today, you will be with me in paradise,"* spoken to a criminal who had at first mocked Jesus with all the rest, highlights the triumph of hope offered to the hopeless. It underscores that in our darkest and worst moments, Jesus offers a word of comfort and peace, continually offering us his presence and his victory.

"Mother, behold your son... Disciple, your mother," reveals the sad loss of family and friends. Yet it also demonstrates the triumph of Jesus' deep concern for the welfare of others and deep desire for his disciples to extend his care by sharing resources with those whom Jesus loves.

"My God, my God, why have you forsaken me" may seem to be only a cry of dereliction, wallowing in abandonment. And yet it is also, as one of Israel's numerous "Prayers of Lament", ultimately, a forlorn cry of faith and trust in one's darkest moments.

There are more sayings which we still have to uncover, but perhaps the most triumphant cry is the statement, *"It is finished,"* – not a cry of despair and resignation, but an exclamation of a purpose achieved, and a goal met, even though its ending appears to be shrouded in defeat.

My goal with all these sayings has not been to "dissect" them and thus remove from them their "life," but rather to seek to experience them together with you so that we might better understand what matters most to the heart of Jesus. The cross is simultaneously Christ's darkest hour, and yet also God's greatest victory in revealing God's steadfast love and faithfulness manifest in Christ – not only for our salvation, but also for our imitation. "Taking up our cross" in some way should produce the triumphant qualities revealed in Christ's "final words" – forgiveness, mercy, care and concern, faithfulness, and integrity to a higher purpose and call. All qualities on triumphant display even during the darkest hours on Calvary.


As you continue your Lenten journey toward Easter Sunday, take the opportunities that come to you... God is with you!


